> SHERYLLN RAWLS, property owner, requested a continuance to gather documents to present to the Board.

Board Member PAPINEAU inquired whether Mr. GUILLEN was a licensed contractor. Ms. RAWLS stated that Mr. GUILLEN did not possess a contactor's license, but that she had other employees who did.

Board Member PAPINEAU inquired about what work had recently been completed on the property. Ms. RAWLS stated that she had been maintaining the yardwork.

Board Member STEED asked Ms. RAWLS how much time she was requesting for a continuance and whether she would be able to secure the property during that time. Mr. STEED stated that the property was a danger.

Chairperson MCCOMB-THANADABOUTH asked what Ms. RAWLS would be able to accomplish with a 30-day continuance. Ms. RAWLS stated that she would have time to collect all documents showing bias from the City of Merced.

Attorney HOVAR addressed the Board and the Appellant and stated that over the last three years the City had been very transparent with their process. Ms. HOVAR stated that Ms. RAWLS had been given sufficient time and opportunities to take corrective action.

Code Enforcement Officer HICKS informed the Board that Ms. Rawls was difficult to contact to provide information.

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Chief Building Official FRAZIER informed the Board that she had informed Ms. Rawls that she could not complete repairs as an owner/builder and would need a license contractor, which led her to submit her appeal stating that she had been denied building permits.

M/S MCCOMB-THANADABOUTH-STEED, and carried by the following vote, to adopt a motion denying the appeal filed by Sherylln Rawls and therefore upholding the Notice and Order to Repair or Abate for the property located at 1041 Northwood Drive, Merced, CA.
