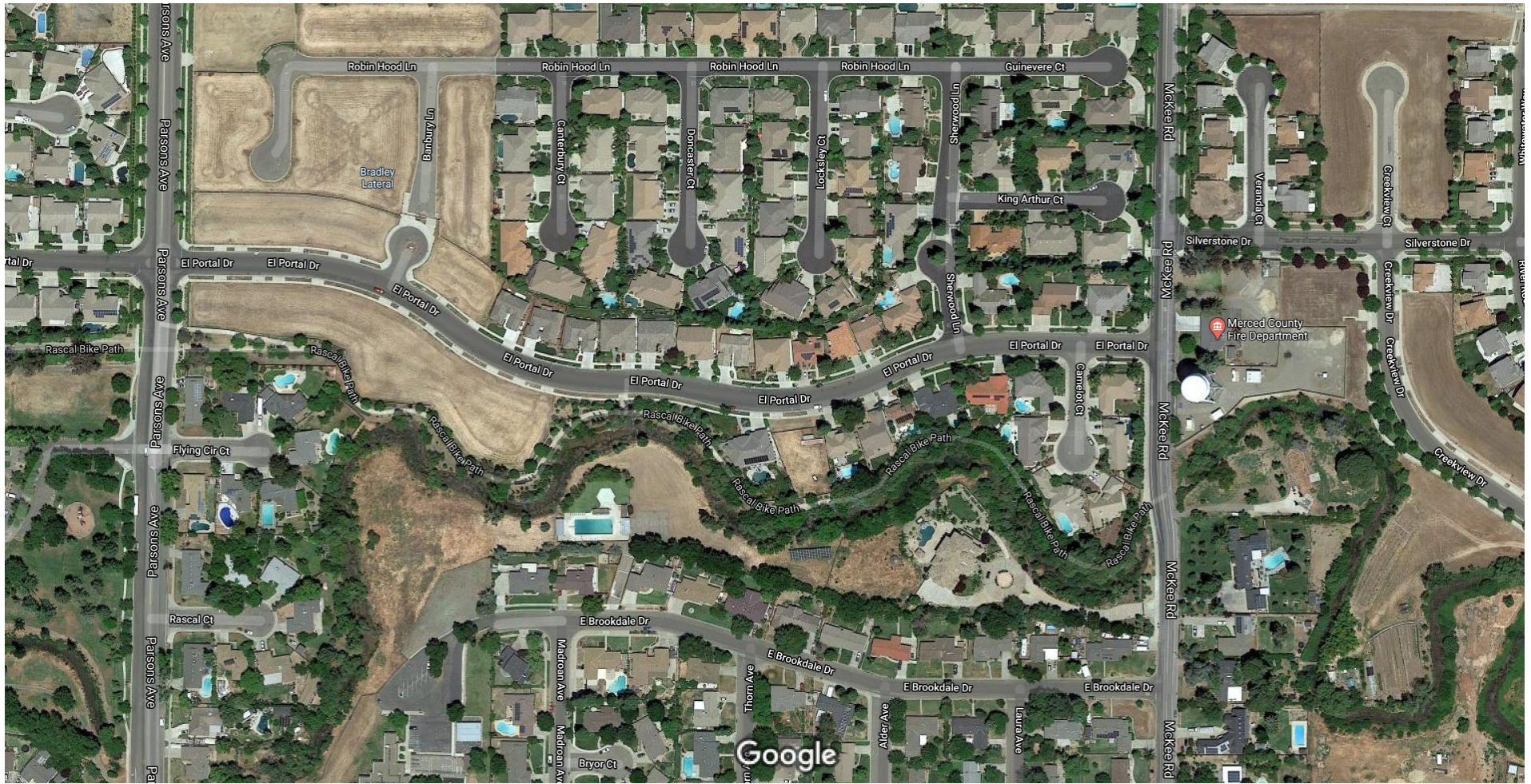

El Portal Dr. between Parsons Ave. and McKee Rd. (See attached map).

Describe Concerns At This Location:

There is steady traffic exceeding safe driving practices and the posted 30 mph speed limit, along with two blind "S" curves along the area. There are two highly trafficked areas that are accessed by cyclists and pedestrians. Rahilly Park is within 0.3 miles of the area. Chenoweth Elementary is within 0.4 miles of the area. Childrens, pets, and seniors are frequently accessing these areas. We have videos capturing drivers not yielding to vehicles already backing up more than half way on the street from the driveway. We get constant complaints of cars not slowing down, yielding or stopping for pedestrians crossing the street to access the community mailboxes. Drivers use El Portal Dr. as a thorough fare. The recent developed at El Moraga has increased the traffic in the area. Recently MPD ticketed two drivers at 47 mph and 58 mph. We are requesting some form of speed control implementation in this area. Perhaps lowering the speed limit to 25 mph. Also, posting more speed limit signs, as right now there is only two 30 mph signs on El Portal one westbound and another eastbound. There are no signs indicating the curves along the street. Most of all, a traffic light at El Portal Dr. and Parsons Ave. should **strongly** be considered. Please prioritize the lives of the children and families living here and the lives of those accessing the schools and parks in the area. Help us prevent a tragedy and keep Merced safe.

Describe Concerns At This Location:

There is a serious speeding problem on this section of El Portal Drive, which is a through street between Parsons and McKee. People are frequently operating their vehicles at speeds well above the posted speed limit, which is 30 MPH (sometimes at speeds as high as 45 to 50 MPH by my estimates). Speeding occurs all day long and every day of the week. This is a residential area, with homes and driveways facing the street, and children and elderly people live here. Many residents have to cross this street to collect their mail from community mailboxes, which is a risky proposition, especially for elderly people with limited mobility. There are two s-curves on the street sufficient enough in radius to blind pedestrians to speeding cars when vehicles are parked on either side of the street. I have been surprised by a speeding vehicle a number of times when crossing the street, even though I made sure there were no vehicles in the vicinity. I am very concerned that a preventable tragedy will occur on El Portal unless steps are taken to substantially reduce speeding. Regular traffic enforcement is needed to deter people from exceeding the speed limit. Recognizing that the Police department has limited resources, other interventions should also be explored. Perhaps you can suggest other ways to remedy this problem. There is also a quality of life impact caused by speeding. The noise levels are very high when people drive at excessive speeds. A lot of trucks use El Portal, which should not be allowed unless they have business on this street or the gated community accessed from El Portal. The University of Merced Campus is essentially closed right now due to the pandemic. I cannot imagine what it will be like when it reopens and students begin again using El Portal to get to and from school. Please put this item on the agenda for the November, 2020, traffic safety committee meeting. Thank you for considering my request.

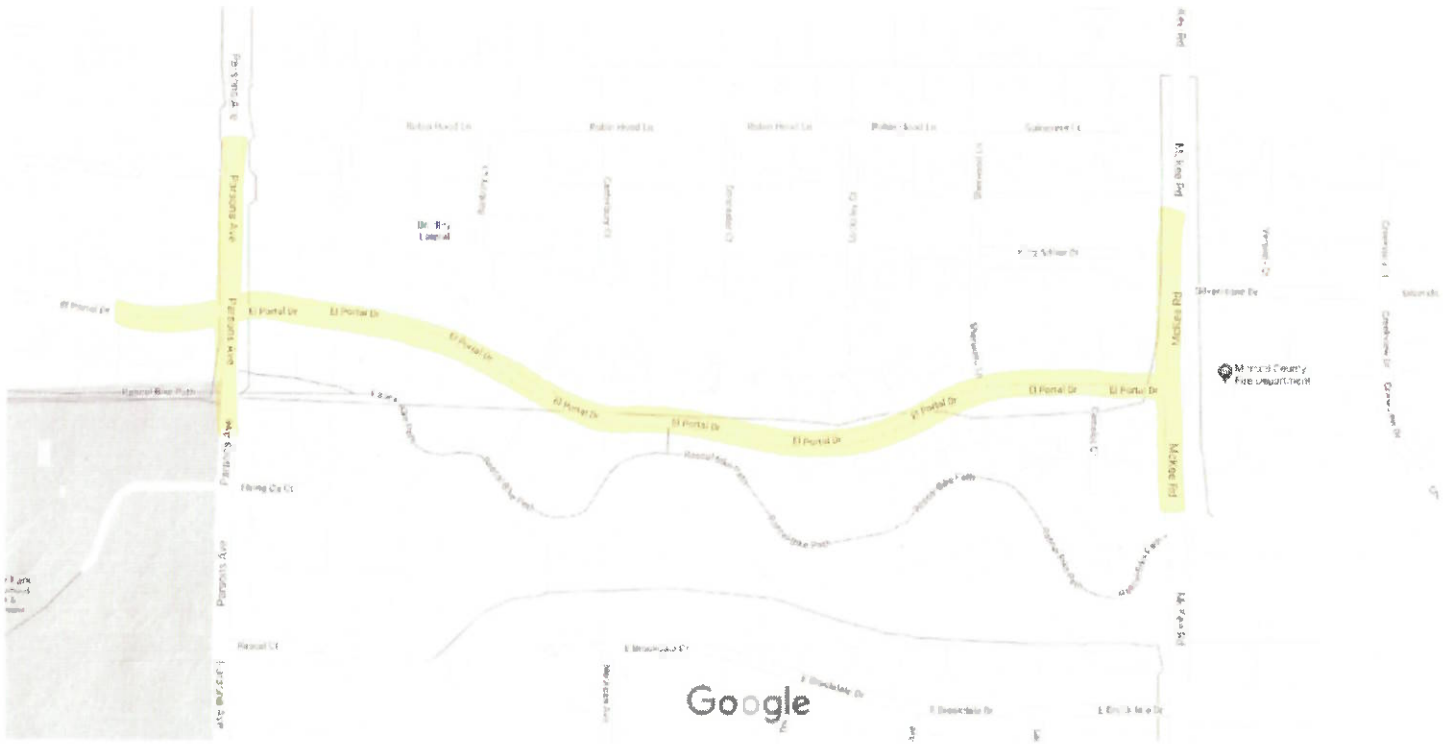

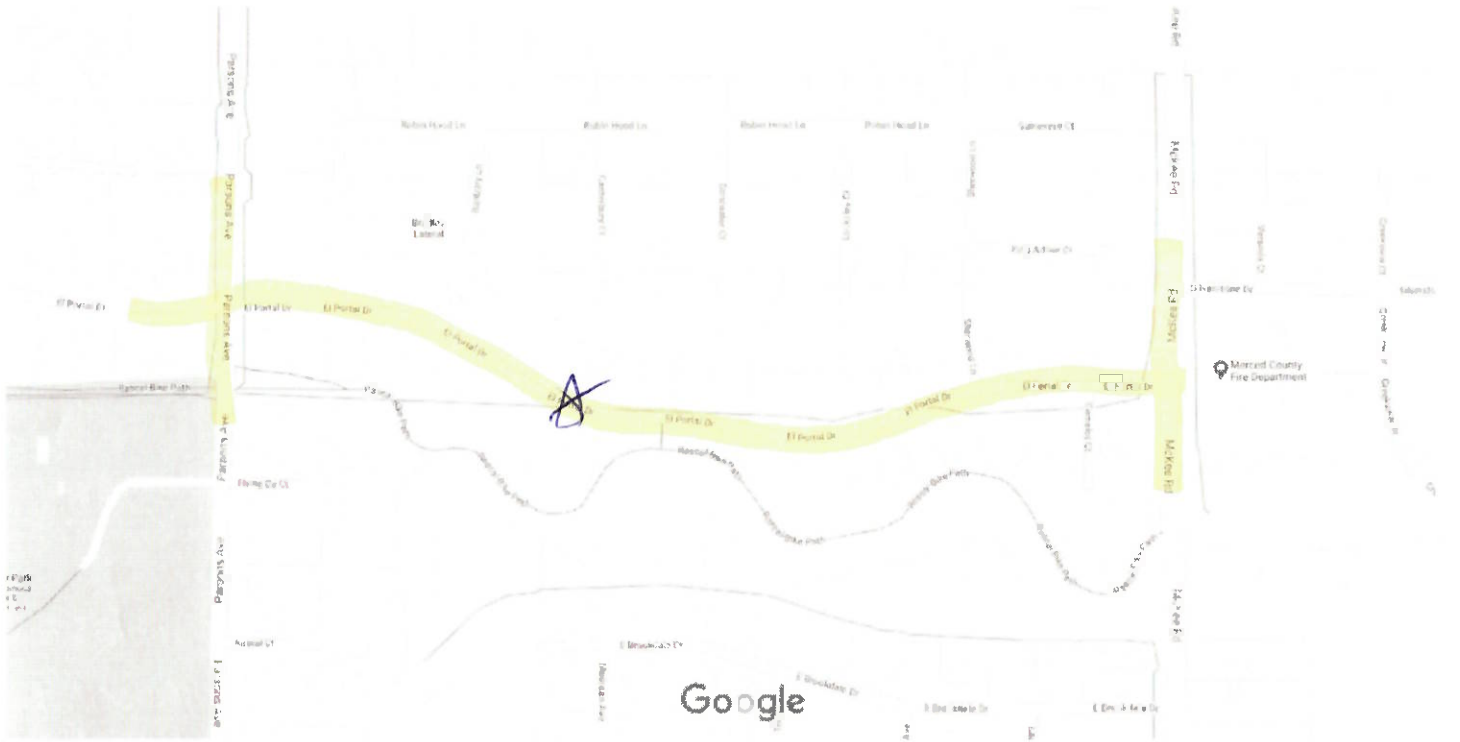
