To Whom It Concerns,

I am writing this email to voice my disapproval of the use of residential homes in my neighborhood for rehab use by Gods Love Outreach Ministries (GLOM) and the fact that the organization is trying to double the number of patients housed in each house. I have been a resident of this neighborhood/community for 10+ years and have enjoyed the peace, tranquility and safety aspects of this neighborhood. I strongly oppose the use of housing in this community for commercial enterprises of any kind. I am appalled that the city will let an organization like GLOM to even rent homes in a residential neighborhood to run rehab facilities. These houses have residents who could potentially exhibit disruptive and dangerous behavior and be a threat to residents and neighbors. Not to mention the fact that housing this many people causes traffic, parking and garbage issues. I am also aware that police calls have increased to our neighborhood due to the rental of these homes (1245 Lurs ct, 1247 Cavalier Ct and 1246 Derby Ct) by GLOM.

I strongly urge the city to deny any permit applications by GLOM to increase the capacity of these rehab homes in our neighborhood. We want the safety and tranquility as well as home values to be preserved and certainly do not want commercial businesses like GLOM to operate out of residential neighborhoods.
