Good after noon. I'm writing again in regards of Glom homes on permit 1246, 1245, 1247. As you see in the print that I'm sending. These people do not even have a state permit to be running this place. I hope that during this last month the planning commission has looked into permits that this place is suppose to have. I am concerned for my family having one of these places a few houses down from me. About 3 weeks ago my son had to stop one client of theirs from going up our doorsteps. That just shows how much they watch their clients. I do not want the bed quantity increased from 6 beds. Please look at their website. They are listing 10 and 12 beds on their websites still. Since your last meeting, they've ignored the fact that you said no and they continue to advertise the same way. They are pretty much ignoring what you said. What does this say about them? Please deny their request and PLEASE look and see they DO NOT HAVE A PERMIT. They cannot even have 2 people in those houses without a permit. Thank you for your time.

According to the California Department of Social Services all 4 of their licenses are currently pending and it states that "A pending facility may not accept clients." I live on 1232 Cavalaire Ct . I've been living here since 2005. We moved into a beautiful neighborhood very quiet and peaceful, not to mention safe. These last few years have become increasingly frustrating with all the UC students moving into houses a couple of houses down. Different people coming in and out of the neighborhood. Noisy parties at night and the parking!!!! I cannot tell you when the last time was that I'm able to park my car in front of my house. We currently have a residential licensed facility with young troubled youth girls across the street having their employees parking in front of my house, now we have ANOTHER one a few houses down on our street and according to what we have looked up on Glom website where this housing is called Gods Live Outreach Ministries they are housing mental health patients. From what we understand the state allows up to six beds. By increasing to 12 beds on Cavalaire and 10 beds on Lurs ct this will only increase traffic, and danger to children playin in our area, less available parking, and these home have only been here for a short time and now facility's want increase of beds . We as home owners disapprove for our safety and property value of our homes going down and lack of parking space. Are you monitoring the employee to patient ratio? And who is monitoring this. And are these patients having background checks with children living across the street? Please do not approve their increase in bed capacity. Think if it was your neighborhood how you would feel. This website is already listing 10 and 12 bed capacity. Did they do this without your approval (Planning Commision) if so why do you even bother to send our letter to "some" residence, because not all residence received them. Please hear our voices.
