1. MID does not have any irrigation or storm drainage facilities within, or adjoining to, the above referenced parcels.

MID requests that the City require, as conditions of approval, the following:

1. If storm water runoff from the site is to be discharged into an MID facility, the Owner would be required to enter into a Storm Drainage Agreement with the MID, paying all applicable fees.
