Dear Mayor, City Council Members, City Manager, and City Attorney,

The behavior of several members of our City Council during the discussion of Item J1 (Redistricting) during the Council Meeting on February 7th, 2022 was reprehensible.

Commentary by members of the council ranged from uniformed and complete falsehoods regarding the ethnic makeup up the redistricting advisory committee to public affronts to the committee-persons themselves by stating that they council "settled" for the members of the committee during the selection process.

Councilmember Ornelas complained about how difficult it is to get participation from the public.
