AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA, **AMENDING SECTIONS 10.28.230 "NO PARKING ZONES" AND 10.32.056, "PASSENGER LOADING** ZONES - PERMANENT" OF THE MERCED MUNICIPAL CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CODE. Section 10.28.230, "No Parking Zones," of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portions of the following streets:

"Street:

Portion:

South Side of 21st Street

Red curbing along the frontage of 1402 E. 21st Street including street parking and blocking of

driveways

West Side of N Street

Red curbing beginning at the southerly curb of the SW Corner of W Childs and N Street, to the northly edge of Reves Elementary's North

Driveway

West Side of N Street

102 feet of Red curbing beginning at the North Edge of the southerly driveway at Reves Elementary thence northerly.

West Side of N Street

32 ft of additional red curbing starting at the South edge of the southerly *Reyes*Elementary driveway thence south

West Side of N Street

20 feet north of the Cartmell Dr crosswalk, throughout the crosswalk, and 20 feet South of the crosswalk."

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO CODE. Section 10.32.056, "Passenger Loading Zones – Permanent," of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portions of the following streets:

"Street:

Portion:

West Side of N Street

85 feet beginning at the South edge of the *Reyes Elementary* 'N' Street Northerly driveway."

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk is directed to cause a summary of this Ordinance to be published in the official newspaper at least once within fifteen (15) days after its adoption showing the vote thereon.
