

ORDINANCE NO. 2553

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING SECTIONS 10.28.230 “NO PARKING
ZONES” AND 10.32.056, “PASSENGER LOADING
ZONES – PERMANENT” OF THE MERCED
MUNICIPAL CODE**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CODE. Section 10.28.230, “No Parking Zones,” of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portions of the following streets:

<i>“Street:</i>	<i>Portion:</i>
South Side of 21 st Street	Red curbing along the frontage of 1402 E. 21 st Street including street parking and blocking of driveways
West Side of N Street	Red curbing beginning at the southerly curb of the SW Corner of W Childs and N Street, to the northly edge of <i>Reyes Elementary’s</i> North Driveway
West Side of N Street	102 feet of Red curbing beginning at the North Edge of the southerly driveway at <i>Reyes Elementary</i> thence northerly.

West Side of N Street 32 ft of additional red curbing starting at the South edge of the southerly *Reyes Elementary driveway* thence south

West Side of N Street 20 feet north of the Cartmell Dr crosswalk, throughout the crosswalk, and 20 feet South of the crosswalk.”

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO CODE. Section 10.32.056, “Passenger Loading Zones – Permanent,” of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portions of the following streets:

<i>“Street:</i>	<i>Portion:</i>
West Side of N Street	85 feet beginning at the South edge of the <i>Reyes Elementary ‘N’ Street</i> Northerly driveway.”

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk is directed to cause a summary of this Ordinance to be published in the official newspaper at least once within fifteen (15) days after its adoption showing the vote thereon.

The foregoing Ordinance was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Merced on the 5th day of September, 2023, and was passed and adopted at a regular meeting of said City Council held on the 18th day of September, 2023, by the following called vote:

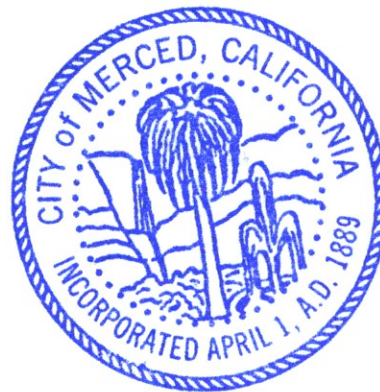

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on September 5, 2023, the City Council of the City of Merced is scheduled to consider the introduction of an Ordinance entitled: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTIONS 10.28.230 "NO PARKING ZONES" AND 10.32.056, "PASSENGER LOADING ZONES - PERMANENT" OF THE MERCED MUNICIPAL CODE** at its regular meeting to be held at 6:00 pm in the City Council Chambers at 678 West 18th Street, Merced, California. The public is invited to provide any oral or written comments regarding this proposed Ordinance. **If adopted, this Ordinance would designate the south side of 21st Street along the frontage of 1402 E. 21st Street, and several areas on the west side of N Street by Reyes Elementary school as no parking zones. This Ordinance would also designate the west side of N Street, 85 feet beginning at the south**

edge of the Reyes Elementary School's N Street northerly driveway as a permanent passenger loading zone.
