

ORDINANCE NO. 2554

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA,  
AMENDING SECTIONS 10.28.230, “NO PARKING  
ZONES,” AND 10.28.380, “STOP INTERSECTIONS  
DESIGNATED” OF THE MERCED MUNICIPAL  
CODE**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES ORDAIN  
AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CODE.** Section 10.28.230, “No Parking Zones,” of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portion of the following street:

*“Street:*

*Portion:*

South side of 312 W. Main  
Street

West of parking entrance, 17 feet  
from last marked parking space”

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO CODE.** Section 10.28.380, “Stop Intersections Designated,” of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portion of the following street:

*“Intersection of M Street and 11th Street”*

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.** If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

**SECTION 4. PUBLICATION.** The City Clerk is directed to cause a summary of this Ordinance to be published in the official newspaper at least once within fifteen (15) days after its adoption showing the vote thereon.

The foregoing Ordinance was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Merced on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2023, and was passed and adopted at a regular meeting of said City Council held on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2023, by the following called vote:


