**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA,  
AMENDING SECTIONS 10.28.230 “NO PARKING  
ZONES,” 10.28.231, “NO TRUCK PARKING  
ZONES,” 10.28.275, “DISABLED PERSONS – ON-  
STREET PARKING,” AND 10.28.295, “LIMITED  
TIME PARKING ZONES – THREE HOURS” OF  
THE MERCED MUNICIPAL CODE**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES ORDAIN  
AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CODE.** Section 10.28.230, “No Parking Zones,” of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portion of the following street:

<i>“Street:</i>	<i>Portion:</i>
Both north and south sides of 15 <sup>th</sup> Street	From G Street to approximately 1030 feet east of G Street”

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO CODE.** Section 10.28.231, “No Truck Parking Zones,” of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portion of the following street:

<i>“Street:</i>	<i>Portion:</i>
West side of West Avenue	From Eagle Street to Riggs Avenue”

**SECTION 3. AMENDMENT TO CODE.** Section 10.28.275, “Disabled Persons – On-Street Parking,” of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portion of the following street:

<i>“Street:</i>	<i>Portion:</i>
East side of B Street	Approximately 460 feet north of Childs Avenue”

**SECTION 4. AMENDMENT TO CODE.** Section 10.28.295, “Limited Time Parking Zones – Three Hours,” of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portion of the following street:

<i>“Street:</i>	<i>Portion:</i>
East side of B Street	From Childs Avenue to the curve at 15 <sup>th</sup> Street”

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

**SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.** If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

**SECTION 7. PUBLICATION.** The City Clerk is directed to cause a summary of this Ordinance to be published in the official newspaper at least once within fifteen (15) days after its adoption showing the vote thereon.
