**PART I: BID INSTRUCTIONS**

It is the intention of the City of Merced (City) to purchase up to the (10) new, 4-door Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicles (half Hybrid, half Direct Fuel Injection) and up to four (4), new Police Responder Supercrew Fleet Pickups. The equipment specified shall be the manufacturer's current production model and shall be bid with all the standard equipment as specified in the manufacturer's printed literature. In addition, the bid response shall include the attached City specifications.

**1. Instructions to Bidders:**

- The complete bid response package must be returned intact. Missing pages or incomplete information may be construed by the City as a non-responsive bid. Non-responsive bids will be rejected.
- Order quantities are estimated up to the numbers aforesaid. Nothing in these estimated quantities must be construed as obligating the City to purchase specific quantities.
- City reserves the right to order additional quantities than stated as approximate amounts after initial award based on Contractor's willingness to hold their bid price and mutually agreed-upon quantities and delivery dates.
- City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, split the bid award, waive minor irregularities, or to accept the bid that best serves the public purpose even if it is not the lowest.

**A place has been provided for each section for which the bidder must enter either "Yes", "No", or "Alternate." Specific sections include the make, model, and other descriptive information needed to clearly describe any alternative offered. If additional spaces are needed, securely attach additional page(s). Additional pages must be numbered clearly and consecutively, include the section number and signed by a responsible company official on the last page submitted.**

2. **Bid Evaluation:** Units offered will be subject to analysis and evaluation by the Fleet Division for quality, construction, material, performance characteristics, and compliance with City's specifications. In evaluating the bids, the City intends to make such comparisons, as it may deem appropriate in order to select the bid, which will result in obtaining the unit that best meets its needs.

The bid evaluation will include, but will not be necessarily limited to, the following factors:

1. Purchase price.

2. Delivery time (in calendar days).
  3. Warranty.
  4. Vendor Past performance.

  4. **Bid Response:** The bidder shall submit to the City a complete bid response package detailing the equipment proposed to meet these specifications. It shall also include warranty.
    - The bid response package consists of the **Pricing Sheet**, the **Technical Specifications** sheets, and a **copy of the dealership's CA Certificate of Reported Compliance for CARBs**.

## **PART II: SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

### **DELIVERY**

Delivery shall be made within **three hundred and sixty-five (365) calendar days** from the date of issuance by the City of the Notice to Proceed. The Contractor must complete delivery in its entirety within **three hundred and sixty-five (365) calendar days** or must receive written approval from the City for an extension of the delivery date. **Any goods deemed by the City to be defective, or any wrong parts shipped in error, must be replaced within thirty (30) calendar days of notification. The City must be notified twenty-four (24) hours in advance of delivery or shipment may be refused.**

Delivery is to be made between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. and during regular City of Merced working days.

### **NON-DELIVERY**

If the Contractor fails to meet delivery requirements, the City may, but is not obligated to, procure the goods from another source and recover any loss occasioned thereby (including, without limitation, any increase in cost and liquidated damages for Contractor's delay up to date of delivery and acceptance by City of goods from another source), from any unpaid balance due the Contractor or through reduction of any future invoices. Otherwise, Contractor will reimburse City within 30 days of receipt of invoice from the City. The price paid by the City shall be considered the prevailing market price at the

time purchase is made. City will notify Contractor of any decision to procure the goods from another source. Such notification may be by telephone, electronic mail, or facsimile to Contractor or Contractor's authorized representative.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Time of delivery is of the essence, and the City and Contractor, by executing the Contract, each agree that actual damages to the City, and actual damages for the inconvenience and loss which will flow to the inhabitants of the City, from any delay in delivery beyond the date or dates provided herein, or portions thereof, are extremely difficult or impossible to determine, and, accordingly, it is agreed that the Contractor shall be liable for and shall pay to the City, as fixed, agreed, and liquidated damages, and not as a penalty the sum of **twenty-five dollars (\$25)** per day for each calendar day of delay in delivery of item(s) from the maximum delivery date as specified herein or in any written extension of time granted by the City. Such payment due the City will be deducted by the City from any payment due to the Contractor for item(s) delivered. Otherwise, Contractor will reimburse City within 30 days of receipt of invoice from the City.

- (c) All equipment and accessories to be furnished must be new and in current production. All products shall conform in design, strength, quality of material and workmanship to current industry standards.
- (d) Each bid shall be accompanied by a copy of any applicable manufacturer's Published Price List or website, and two copies of the manufacturer's descriptive literature and specifications or website, including a copy of the manufacturer's standard warranty.
- (e) All equipment and accessories shall comply with regulations of the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and the California Occupational Safety and Health Administration (Cal/OSHA), whichever is more stringent.


