## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT #24-01 AND NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION

A public hearing will be held by the Merced City Council on Monday, November 4, 2024, at 6:00 PM or as soon thereafter as may be heard in the City Council Chambers located at 678 W. 18<sup>th</sup> Street, Merced, CA concerning Zoning Ordinance Amendment #24-01, initiated by the City of Merced. This application involves changes to the Merced Zoning Ordinance (Title 20 of the Merced Municipal Code) which would amend Merced Municipal Code Section 20.44.170 ("Commercial Cannabis Businesses"). This amendment includes modifying the Phase 1 Initial Review Requirements and clarifying Phase 2 Scoring Correction Authority and Timelines and Qualified Commercial Cannabis Business list expiration.

At the meeting, the City Council will also consider the introduction of an Ordinance entitled:

"An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Merced, California, Amending Section 20.44.170, 'Regulation of Commercial Cannabis Activities – Commercial Cannabis Business Permit Required,' of the Merced Municipal Code to Allow City Council Consideration of Alternative Sites for Retail Cannabis Business Applications under Appeal, and Include a Local Ownership Element for Cannabis Retail Permits Issued after November 3, 2021."

If enacted, this ordinance would amend the City's cannabis regulations as described above. On August 7, 2024, the Planning Commission considered this matter at a duly noticed public hearing and recommended that the City Council adopt the Ordinance.
