Subject: Agenda Item I.14. 24-1150 SUBJECT: Second Reading and Final Adoption of an Ordinance Amending Chapter 9.51, "Camping and Storage of Personal Property" of the Merced Municipal Code

Enact the ordinance to empower the Merced Police Department to remove loitering transients from city parks. Enabling transients to degrade public parks with their behaviors that result in clothing, partially eaten food, single use plastics, toilet paper, human waste, and abandoned Home Depot carts does not serve the community. It creates a public nuisance and a health hazard.

Obviously, the people on the streets are not capable of taking care of themselves mentally or physically; get them off the streets and return clean parks and streets back to the community. This includes the creeks that run through this community. Be the champion to bring MID and Department of Water Resources to the table to eliminate transients on the watersheds.

Each Cart will have a tracker in the handle and will be confiscated fees are not met daily

Rental Cost Large Cart \$2.50 per day 16yrs old to 50 yrs. old. Small cart \$1.50 per day 16yrs old to 100 yrs. old.

\$1.50 per day for 50 yrs. old -100 yrs. Old. Fees are due at the End of the day not the beginning unless a client has the upfront cost and must pass inspection before a client can re rent it the next day.

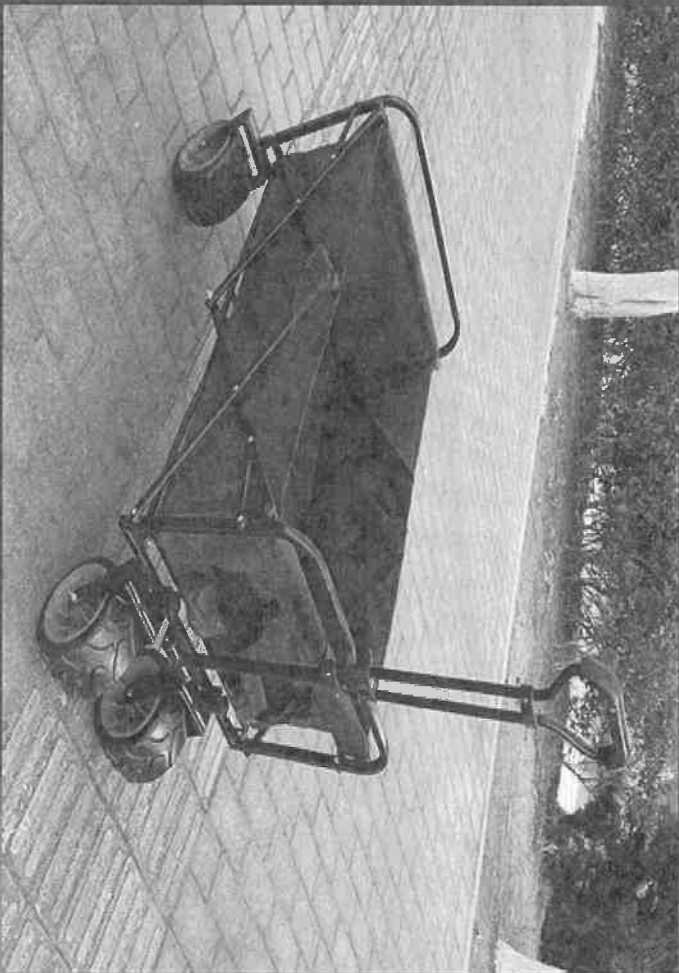
Daily Rental / Monthly Lease or Own Individual Shopping Carts

Client will daily clean all trash items using the recycling and trash I must separate all garbage areas through our different locations across our town or when they check in for the night they can clean at the Center in designated area

Client will wash cart daily and before retiring if not checking out for more than one day at a time

Any purposeful damage to any Cart will result in a destruction of property charge with requirements to pay resolution for damages
