SUBJECT: Update on Commission Vacancies

BACKGROUND

Attached is the Public Roster for the Bicycle Advisory Commission. Presently, there are two "Ex-Officio member" vacancies, as well as four member terms expiring on July 1, 2017. Commissioners Tom Hothem and Isai Palma have expressed their desire to be reappointed to the Commission; their applications have been received by the City Clerk's Office.

Commissioners Robert Tyler and Lisa Kayser-Grant have both served two consecutive terms and are ineligible for reappointment. The City has not yet received enough applications to fill these vacancies and would like to request the Commissioners whose terms will be expiring to continue to serve on the Commission until a replacement can be appointed by the City Council.

In addition to these changes, it is important to note a clerical error in respects to Commissioner Justin Hick's appointment. The current roster shows Mr. Hick's term expiring in *July 2018*, however, his appointment will continue through July 2019. This will be corrected on the official roster when current vacancies are filled.
