

#### A Community Plan is ...

- Consistent with the City's General Plan
- Describes future services and infrastructure for a smaller area covered by the City's General Plan.
- Policy Document that includes a Land Use Map and Circulation Plan
- Adopted by City Council upon recommendation by City Planning Commission.

#### General Plan Guidance

- Bellevue Road Urban Village and Employment Center
- Compatibility with Adjacent Neighborhoods
- Provide for all transportation modes
- Bellevue Road to unify, not separate neighborhoods
- Consider Influences from UCM and University
   Community
- Provide for a variety of housing styles and densities
