

## **Notice of Public Meeting for HUD Annual Action Plan Fiscal Year 2016-17 Substantial Amendment**

The City of Merced will conduct a public meeting on November 30, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, Housing Division, 678 W. 18<sup>th</sup> Street, Merced, CA, to discuss the revision of funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The City of Merced is recommending a revision is to fund the Gateway Terrace II Apartment complex. The proposed development would construct 50 affordable housing units with a minimum of 11 units reserved for veterans.
